A term has two semesters. Students receive two progress report grades and two semester/permanent grades per term.

- ❖ **Progress Report:** An indication of a student's progress. Not a permanent grade.
- ❖ **Semester/Permanent Grades:**
 - Appear on Transcript
 - Determine GPA and class rank
 - Considered by colleges and universities when granting admittance and awarding financial aid

Progress and Semester Report Cards are sent to the mailing address entered on a student's emergency card.
