The EPT and the ELM **are not admission tests**; instead, they determine eligibility to enroll in specific courses. If you are required to take these but fail to do so, you will not be allowed to register for General Education courses at the CSU. You may take the tests at any CSU campus.

Cost is \$20 per test

The California State University (CSU) requires you to take the English Placement Test (EPT) and the Entry Level Mathematics (ELM) exam prior to enrollment in the CSU **unless you are exempt** by means of other scores:

EPT:

- A score of 550 or above on the Evidence Based Reading and Writing Section of the NEW SAT.
- A score of 22 or above on ACT English Test
- A score of 3 or above on either the Language and Composition or Composition and Literature AP test
- A score of Standard Exceeded: "Ready for CSU college-level English courses" on the EAP
- A score of Standard Met: "Ready for CSU - Conditional" on the EAP, provided successful completion of the Expository Reading and Writing Course (ERWC), or AP English.

ELM:

- A score of 570 or above on the mathematics section of the NEW SAT.
- A score of 550 or above on a Mathematics SAT Subject Test (level 1 or level 2)
- A score of 23 or above on the ACT Mathematics Test
- A score of 3 or above on the AP Stats, Calculus AB or Calculus BC exam
- A score of Standard Exceeded: "Ready for CSU college-level mathematics courses" on the EAP
- A score of Standard Met: "Ready for CSU college-level mathematics courses - Conditional" on the EAP, provided successful completion of a CSU-approved 12th grade math course that requires Algebra II as a prerequisite.

Scoring: Students who score **below 138** on the EPT and **below 50** on the ELM will be required to participate in Early Start Program the summer before enrolling in the freshman year.
