In order to create your own unique account, you will need to supply information such as your name, date of birth, e-mail address, etc. Your personal e-mail address is as important to us as your street mailing address or your phone number since the CSU campuses will use your e-mail address to communicate with you. - ### Term Type:
- ❖ We are a **semester term type** – two grades per year. As you list classes, each will have a Fall semester grade and a Spring semester grade, regardless of the term in which you took the class. **List courses carefully!!**
 - ❖ Make sure you have listed the required number of courses for each area, A-G.
 - ❖ Make sure you include current courses as **'in progress'**. Include next term's courses as **'planned'**.
 - ❖ Government and Economics only receive **one** semester grade each.
 - ❖ **For Area G** – only use college prep courses ('p' on transcript) that you have not listed in other categories. P/E Science, Creative writing, psychology, or your third year of foreign language, are good choices.



The application will save, you do not need to complete it in a single sitting. To come back to the application, select the 'resume' box next to the School name on the application screen.

After you complete one CSU application, and **get it reviewed** by Mrs. Galbraith or your counselor, you can begin another – your information will be imported onto the next application, though you will need to complete the first page of each new application with specific information pertaining to that particular College.

Remember to pay for your application (\$55 each) with a credit card, and submit it *long before* the November 30th deadline!
