Senior Information

Senior Contracts are in effect as of Monday, March 13th! Don't jeopardize walking in the ceremony because of a lapse of judgement. We are in the home stretch— YOU CAN DO THIS!!! As a reminder, the following points are from the Senior Contract.

ACADEMIC

- Complete all academic requirements by May 19, 2017.
- Pass all required classes, earning a minimum of 240 credits.
- Complete and verify through the Counseling Department any additional credits by May 19, 2017.

ATTENDANCE

- Maintain good attendance in all classes. Excessive absences may result in Administrative action. (Excessive is generally defined as 10 or more excused full or partial school days.)
- Complete all Saturday School Detention sessions by May 20, 2017.
- A student will be considered "truant" and may not be allowed to participate in the closing senior events and/or graduation ceremony if the student has 3 all-day unexcused absences or 3 unexcused absences in the same period.

BEHAVIOR

- Must behave in a mature, responsible manner. If suspended for any reason during the 4th Quarter, student may not be able to participate in the graduation ceremony or Senior activities. This behavior standard applies at school and any school-sponsored activity.
- Attend mandatory graduation practice on May 25, 2017. A student may not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony if he/she fails to attend the graduation practice. Students will not be excused to go to work.

FINES

- Pay all outstanding fines to your school by May 19, 2017.

We are excited to inform you that UMHS has enrolled with STOPit!

[STOPit](#) is an online reporting tool designed to deter and mitigate bullying and cyber abuse, consisting of an app and a back-end incident management system for school administrators.

Our students will have access to the STOPit mobile app, which has two simple but powerful features.

Report can be used by students to report incidents to school contacts anonymously.

Get Help can be used to engage in anonymous two-way communication with school contacts.

Both Report and Get Help empower students to stand up for themselves and for one another. Students have the power to help put an end to harmful and inappropriate behavior they see online through social media and other means. They can use STOPit to reach out for help if they or a peer are facing a personal crisis or experiencing bullying, abuse, or are otherwise in need of assistance. Our goal with STOPit is to create a safer, kinder school community, both online and off.

No student information is needed to use STOPit. The only way personally identifiable information will be accessible through STOPit is if a student voluntarily includes it within the content of a report or message.

With your approval, please encourage your student to download the STOPit App for free from the Apple or Google App store. The Access code for our school is: UMHS
