"I understand that participating in this year's senior closing events and the graduation ceremony is a privilege. To be eligible to participate, I must maintain the established criteria for academic achievement, attendance, and behavior during the 4th quarter of my senior year. To ensure that I may participate in the senior closing events and/or the graduation ceremony, I understand that I must meet all of the following criteria."

- Academic; Pass Classes
- Discipline; No Suspensions or discipline-issues at school functions
- Attendance; No more than 6 **excused** absences (full or partial days), no more than 3 unexcused absences, no more than 3 Tardies and student must complete all Saturday School assignments and serve detentions.
- Fines; Pay outstanding fines to the finance office by May 21, 2018.
- Attend Graduation Practice on May 24th.

What happens if Contract is broken?

*"If I fail to meet the criteria outlined in this document and become ineligible to participate in any of the senior events, I will have the opportunity to **APPEAL** that decision with the Senior Appeal Committee. I understand the school principal shall make all appeal decisions in relation to participation in the graduation ceremony."*

A request for appeal must be submitted in writing no later than May 11, 2018. The Appeal Committee will meet the week of May 14, 2018 in relation to senior events. The principal will make decisions regarding the graduation ceremony. If your appeal is denied and your privilege is revoked, you could be denied admittance the ceremony as a spectator.

- The ceremony is a dignified ceremony, not a party. We appreciate parental and community support. Please do not encourage or assist with disruptive behavior.

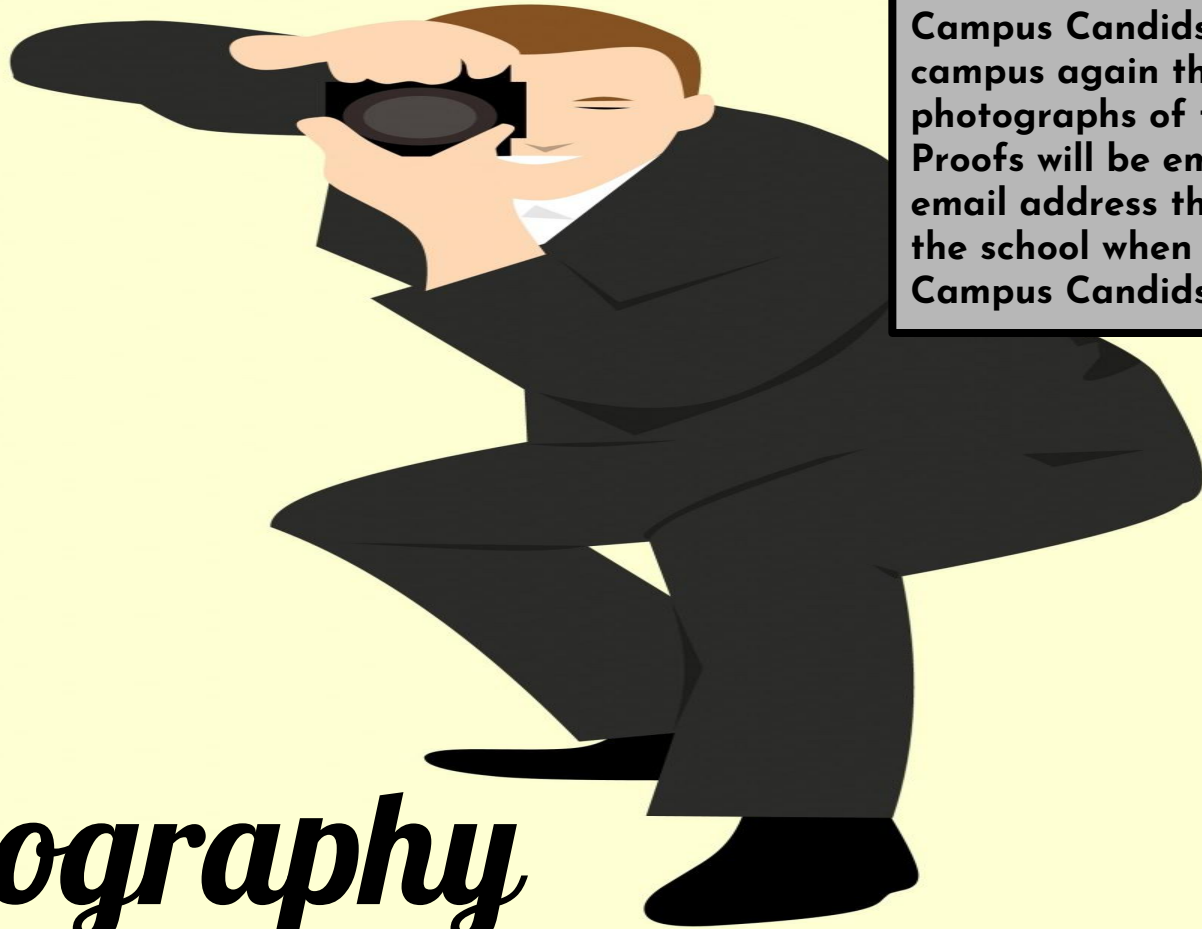
Assisted Seating and Parking

Assisted seating is designed for family of graduates who cannot navigate the bleachers for health and safety reasons. Each reservation will come with two tickets for entrance at the snack bar and one parking pass for admittance to the staff lot by the maintenance shop. - Graduates will be searched for items that are not permitted during stadium; these items include and are not limited tortillas, frisbees, inflatables, foam fingers.

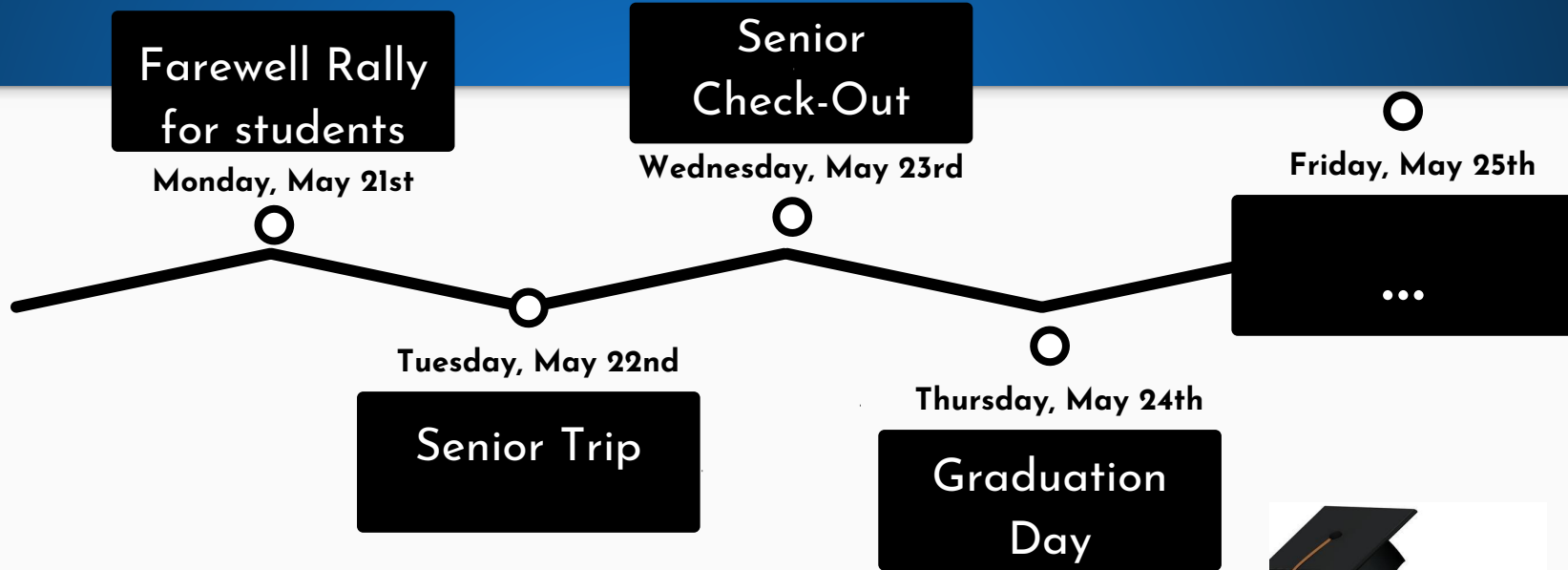



Senior Check-Out


Seniors will receive their check-out forms from counseling the week prior to graduation. The time that they need to report to the check-out will be printed on each form. To be "signed-off" seniors will need to have the following completed:

- *All school owned materials (books, jerseys, etc.) returned*
- *Fines paid. Cash only in the month of May.*
- *Saturday Schools and/or detentions served*
- *Verify name to counseling for diploma*
